- 1. The information reported herein supplements the testimony recorded in the Naval Court of Inquiry report on the loss of the U.S.S. Serpens (AK-97). The information pertains to the identification and history of the 350 pound Torpex Depth Bombs, Mark 54 which were being loaded.
- 2. The bombs had been stored at Guadalcanal in the custody of companies attached to the 353rd Army Ordnance Battalion. Officers of the Battalion report the records show the following:

301 Torpex Depth Bombs 350 lb. Mark 54 were taken over from the 13th Army Air Force about 1 August 1944 at the Koli Bomb Dump.

2668 Bombs were actually received from the S.S. E.A. Burnett at the Koli Bomb Dump about 13 October 1944.

1149 Bombs were actually received from the S.S. James B. Francis at Kukum Bomb Dump about 3 November 1944.

There were loaded on the U.S.S. Serpens at the time of the explosion:

187 Bombs from the 13th Air Force. 2587 Bombs from the S.S. E.A. Burnett. 625 Bombs from the S.S. James B. Francis.

Bombs from the S.S. James B. Francis were being loaded on the U.S.S. Serpens at the time of the explosion.

3. Information concerning the identification and history of the bombs received from the 13th Air Force is not now available at Guadalcanal. Records which may identify this lot are reported to be at the new headquarters of the 13th Air Force.
